

## The benevolent AFF path maintenance team doesn't stop working with snow

**T**uesday morning is the ritual work day for path maintenance on the "25 Bosses" trail in the "3 Pignons" area.



This path is especially vulnerable to erosion since its sand is under heavy foot threat, due to the huge number of users. We spotted the Roche au Four West slope since it is one of the erosion-prone areas with grooves up to 40 cm deep. Actually, some wooden stairs had been installed there some years ago, but they are not sufficient anymore. Thus we built 4 new steps in Robinia, and some others will follow next Tuesday.



The Terrain Commission is the operational body of the AFF.

It has the duty of every work on the field, in tight cooperation with the Office National des Forêts (ONF).

It is composed of 72 benevolent members; among them are 56 trail markers.
